On June 27, 1957 this well was spudded at 4:00 A. M. On June 28, 1957, we ran 270' of 7 5/8", 26.40 casing J-55 landed @ 279' and cemented with 200 sac 50 - 50 Poemix, 2% Calcium Chloride and circulated to the surface @ 10:30 A. M. After allowing the cement to set 24 hours, 800# pressure was applied & held for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. The plug was drilled out and 800# pressure was applied and held for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure and drilling ahead was resumed.
