Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

On July 19, 1957 this well was spudded at 6:00 P. M. Total depth of 283' was reached at 9:00 P. M. July 19, 1957. We ran 10 1/2" 7 5/8" 26.40# J-55, 270', casing and landed @ 282'. Cemented with 200 sac 50-50 Poemix, 2% Calcium Chloride. Cement circulated. Plug down @ 1 A. M. 7-20-57. After allowing the cement to set 24 hours, 800# pressure was applied and held for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. The plug was drilled out and 800# pressure was applied and held for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure and drilling ahead was resumed.
