Gentlemen:

United States Smelting Refining and Mining Company drilled the subject well to 12,750' in barren dolomite. At this depth Operator encountered water on a drill stem test from 12688-12750', and as a result of this test, Great Western Drilling Company expressed a desire to acquire the well and produce the water for use in connection with a water flood program in the Caprock-Queen Area. Therefore, effective January 6, 1958, United States Smelting Refining and Mining Company released subject well to Great Western Drilling Company, and at that time, Form C-103 was filed to advise the Commission of this change.

Since United States Smelting Refining and Mining Company drilled the well, we have prepared and are submitting to your office at this time six copies of Form C-105 "Well Record," one copy each of Schlumberger Gamma Ray-Neutron Log, Induction Log, Electric Log, and one photo copy of Agreement between Great Western Drilling Company and United States Smelting Refining and Mining Company.

With the filing of this Form C-105, United States Smelting Refining and Mining Company has met all the requirements of the Commission in its connection with the subject well, henceforth, all correspondence, and/or reports that the Commission may require in regard to this well should be directed to Great Western Drilling Company, Post Office Box 1659, Midland, Texas.
