

SUPERIOR STATE

1. Rigged up rotary, drilled cement to bottom of hole at 12,356'.
2. Squeezed perforations 12,338-12,344' with 25 sacks of Cement.
3. Perforated 12,332-12338' with four shots per foot. Swabbed load, swabbed 100% water.
4. Attempted to squeeze perforations 12332-12338', unable to break down formation.
5. Set bridge plug at 12,328'. Perforated 12,312-12,324' with four shots per foot, swabbed load and formation water.
6. Drilled out bridge plug at 12,328'. Re-perforated 12,332-12,338' with 4 shots per foot. Attempted to squeeze perforations, formation would not break. Acidized with 500 gallons.
7. Squeezed perforations 12,312-12,324' and 12,332-12,338' with 50 sacks of Slo Set Cement, reversed out 32 sacks.
8. Drilled cement to 12,330'. Perforated 12,312-12,324' with 8 shots per foot. Swabbed dry. Acidized with 1000 gallons mud acid. Recovered load oil, no show oil, gas, or water. Acidized with 5000 gallons regular acid.
9. From July 24, 1956, to August 20, 1956, tested well by swabbing and flowing on various size chokes. Recovered formation water with some oil.
10. On August 21, 1956, well died. Swabbed 19 hours at rate of 11 barrels of water per hour with slight seum of oil.
11. Shut well in. Waiting on orders.
12. Prep. to plug and abandon.
