Gentlemen:

The above named well has produced less than thirty days since completion, and water encroachment has caused the well to be incapable of flowing production. We are now in the process of recompleting the well at a depth above the original completion, as shown on Form C-102 filed June 27, 1956.

We respectfully request sixty days extension to New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule No. 302, titled Sub-Surface Pressure Tests on New Pools, which requires a bottom hole pressure to be taken thirty days after the completion of a discovery well.
