8-5/8" casing set at 3950' and circulated to surface with cement.  
No casing to be recovered. Will fill hole with heavy mud, spot cement plug (31 sacks) from 9913' to 10013', spot cement plug (31 sacks) from 8800' to 8900' and spot cement plug (31 sacks) from 3900' to 4000'. Place 20 sacks cement in top of casing and place 4" pipe marker.
