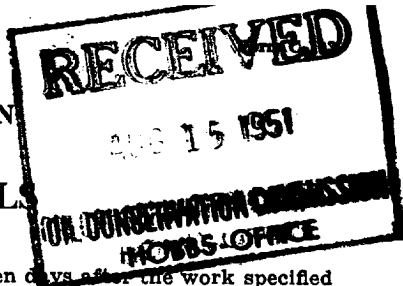

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 11,000', Plugged Back Depth 9045'. Acidized 5-1/2" casing perforations, from 90015 to 9045', with 6000 Gal. Dowell XF-29, 15% L.T. Acid. Started acid down tubing on vacuum. Pumped in 90 bbls. and tubing pressure rose to 100#. Injection rates - 3.5 bbls. per min. after pumping in 90 bbls, 3.2 bbls. per min. at end of treatment & after 36 bbls. oil flush. After testing thirteen (13) days the well flowed 16.60 bbls. oil, no water, in 24 hours, through a 16/64" choke, T.P. 50#, C.P. 235#, gas volume 48,000 cu ft per day, GOR 2700.
