11083' Total Depth, 9050' PBD. Nippled up on 5½" Csg. Went inhole & washed out cement to 9467'. Ran Lane-Wells, & perforated 5½" csg. from 9127' to 9148' w/4 shots per Ft. Made DST. from 9094' to 9148', results unsatisfactory. Acidized w/500 gals. Dowell IF-18 acid, started swabbing, results unsatisfactory. Set reatiner at 9103' & squeezed with 50 sx. cement. Perforated 5½" Csg. from 9040' to 9045' w/20 shots. Set Packer at 8852' & started swabbing, results unsatisfactory. We propose to acidise well.
