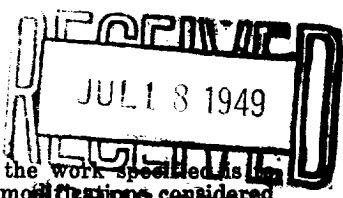

11083' Total Depth, Lime. Finished drilling 7-3/8" hole at 7:15 P.M. 7-8-49. Took Drill Stem Test from 11020' to 11075', recovered 4565' dry pipe, 2100' Water Blanket, 552' Water cut drilling mud & 3858' Sulphur water. Ran Lane-Wells Survey & Schlumberger Survey. We propose to set cement plugs from 10969' to 11083' and from 9407' to 9623' and set casing at approximately 9500' and cement with 600 sacks cement.
