DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

11,115' - Total Depth - Line & Chert. Ran Schlumberger Surveys. Cement plug from 11,115' to 11,001' W/35 sacks regular cement and from 8820' to 8706' W/35 sacks regular cement, and from 3860' to 3773' W/25 sacks regular cement, and from 2180' to 2100' W/25 sacks regular cement. Shot off 8-5/8" casing at 825' & recovered same. Cement plug from 310' to 243' W/45 sacks regular cement. Plugged top of 13-3/8" casing W/10 sacks cement. Set a piece of 4" Line Pipe, cemented in center of surface casing, 5' above ground. Heavy mud between above plugs. Well plugged and abandoned at 3:30 A.M., 7-15-51.
