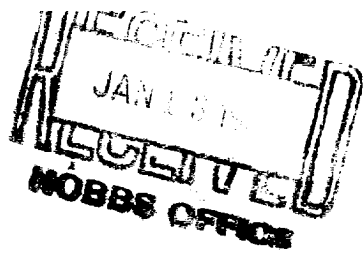

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Acidized with 4000 gallons of 15% hydrochloric acid by Chemical Process Company. Injection time 40 minutes, duration 1 hour and 10 minutes. Casing pressure 1500#, tubing pressure 1500#. Swabbed 27½ bbls. of water in 3½ hours and then flowed 98 bbls. of oil and 47 bbls. of water in 12 hours. Now flowing approximately 1 bbl. of fluid per hour, cut 35%. Tubing pressure 150#, 3/4" choke open, gas 1,612,600 cubic feet.
