

Rigged up and ran 9 joints, 13-3/8" O.D. 35.06#, Kane-Wald range 2, Slip joint casing (new) and set at 305.57' and cemented with 175 sacks Long Horn Common Cement & 50 sacks Incon cement. Plug to 290.57' at 3:30 P.M. 1-6-50. Maximum pump pressure 300#, cement circulated.
