DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

11,199' Total Depth 10,145 P.B.D. Line - Current production from perforations in 5-1/2" casing from 10,120' to 10,135'. On test of 1/21/54 flowed 13 bbls oil and 2,240 bbls water in 24 hrs on gas lift. Well is no longer economically productive from this zone.

Propose to pull tubing and flow valves, set retainer and squeeze present perforations (10,120' - 10,135') w/ 150 sz cement, set cast iron bridging plug at approximately 8900' and dump one sack cement on plug. Perforate 5-1/2" casing from 8800' to 8824' and from 8832' to 8840' and acidize with 500 gallons acid and swab to test. If necessary will re-acidize with 1,000 gallons acid. Production will be from Permian-Pennsylvanian zone.
