DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

9620' - Total Depth - Line. Ran open-end drill pipe and spotted cement plugs as follows: 35 sx from 9618' to 9508'; 35 sx from 8600' to 8488'; 35 sx from 3850' to 3738' and 25 sx from 2000' to 1920'. Ran McGallough Magnatester and found 8-5/8" casing stuck at 703', 90% free at 690'. Ran cutting tools and cut 8-5/8" casing at 692'; recovered 682.70' of casing. Spotted 50 sx cement from 300' to 240'. Put 12' cement plug in top of 13-3/8" casing with 4" pipe extending 5' above ground in center of top plug. Finished and started tearing down tools at 11PM, 6-2-52. All tools off location at 2PM, 6-4-52. Well plugged and abandoned.
