FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

9012' - Total Depth - Line. Finished drilling 6-3/4" hole at 12:15 P.M., 8-11-50. No oil or gas zones of consequence were encountered. It is our intention to plug and abandon this well, after running Schlumberger's Electrical and Gamma Ray Surveys. We propose to plug the well as follows: 40 sacks cement from total depth to 8435', 50 sacks cement from 8434' to 8433', 25 sacks cement from 3870' to 3765' and 25 sacks cement from 1500' to 1396'. Cut 7-5/8" casing at approx. 650' and recover same. Dump 10 sacks cement in top of 11-3/4" surface casing and set a piece of 4" Line Pipe, cemented in center of surface casing, extending 5' above surface of the ground. Heavy mud between all of the above cement plugs.
