**FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK**  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Plan to plug and abandon well according to following procedure:

1. Set 150' cement plug in bottom of well. (9650'-9500')
2. Set 150' cement plug near bottom of salt string; 75' below salt string and 75' up into salt string. (4135' up to 3985')
3. Set 100' cement plug up to surface. (100' to 0')
4. All intervals between plugs filled with mud laden fluid.
5. Set a 4" pipe marker in cement to extend 4' above ground level.

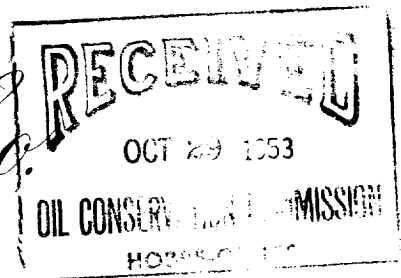
