Dear Mr. Antweil:

The office of the Commission in Santa Fe has had a request from the bonding company for cancellation of the \$10,000 bond covering the operations of Jack White in the Lazy J Pool of Lea County.

In checking our files we find that plugging reports have been filed by your office for the Duncan White No. 1-E and No. 2-F in Section 34, T-13-S, R-33-E. The files also reflect that you were advised by letter dated January 15, 1957 that it would be impossible to approve the plugging reports until certain conditions had been corrected to comply with Commission Rules and Regulations. The letter also requested that you notify this office when these things had been done so that a final inspection might be made. We have not as yet received this notice.
