We are writing in regard to the White-Geror Duncan-White Nos. 1 and 2 in Section 34, T-13-S, R-33-E which you have recently plugged.

Mr. Bill Gressett, Oil and Gas Inspector for the Commission has made an inspection of the location for these wells and has found that at the No. 1 well the marker is not cemented and one dead man wire has not been cut. At the No. 2 well he found that the dead man wires were not cut and the quarter quarter section is not on the marker.

Please advise this office when these things have been done so that a final inspection may be made and the report of plugging approved without further delay.
