Ran 4080' of 9 5/8" 36# Seamless J-55 Casing and set at 4092'. Cemented with 1900 sacks Pozmix "S" cement mixture, 238 sacks of Stratacrete, 34 sacks of Howcogel and 200 sacks Neat. Circulated 70 sacks. Tested pipe and casing seat for 30 minutes with 1000 psi before and after the drilling out of the cement on March 20, 1954, and both held 0.K.
