

Well was drilled to a total depth of 10,048' without encountering oil or gas in commercial quantity; therefore well was plugged and abandoned in the following manner: Shot 5 1/2" casing at 8100' and pulled 249 joints 8092'. Cut 9 5/8" casing at 418' and pulled same. Spotted the following cement plugs.

20 sacks from 9684' to 9852'.
35 sacks from 8010' to 8110'.
30 sacks from 5720' to 5620'.
30 sacks from 4129' to 4229'.
15 sacks in top of 13 3/8" casing.
