DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On June 14, 1952 acidized thru 2-3/8" tubing w/perforations in anchor 9886-9844' w/2000 gallons 15% NE acid by Cardinal Chemical Inc. Started acid in tubing 4:35 PM 14th, acid on formation 6:23 PM. Tubing pressure 500#, casing pressure 500#. Average injection rate 60 GPM, injection time 33 min., duration 1 hr 7 min. Flushed w/40 bbls oil. Job complete 6:56 PM 14th.

RESULTS: Started swabbing 7:30 PM 14th. Swabbed 40 bbls oil and 41 bbls acid water in 4 hrs ending 11:30 PM 14th. Flowed 48 bbls oil & 49 water in 4 1/2 hrs ending 4:00 AM 6-15-52. Flowed 354 bbls oil & 162 bbls water thru 2-3/8" tubing, 1/2" choke in 24 hrs ending 4:00 AM 16th. 40.2 gr., 34% BS. Gas 382,600 cf 24 hr rate. TP 150#, CP, packer-0#
