Plug to 4159' at 3:15 P.M., June 20, 1950. Maximum pump pressure 1300#.**

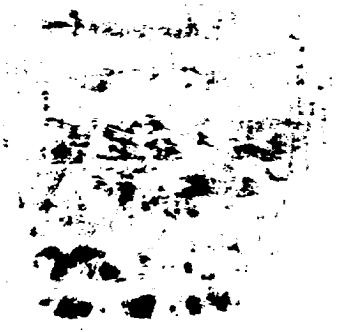
