Pulled tubing and packer. Perforated casing, Penn. formation, 10197-10314' (EL & RL). Set 2-3/8" tubing. Acidized with 7000 gallons retarded 15% acid through perforations. Formation produced no oil or gas. Displaced oil in annulus with water. Pulled tubing. Set cast iron bridge plug at 10100'. Dumped 1 sack cement on plug; top of cement at 10096'.

Well temporarily abandoned - to be held for possible water disposal or injection use.



