Pressured up to 500 pounds of casing and held for 30 minutes. No leaks were found.
Proposed casing program on form C101 indicated that 350' of 13 3/8 would be set.
Verbal approval was obtained from Mr. C. F. Montgomery to change this to 317 feet.
Red beds were encountered at 270 feet.
