Spudded well at 11:00 PM, January 5, 1955. At total depth of 345', set 13-3/8" conductor casing at 342' and cemented with 220 sacks cement with 6% gel. Plug down at 6:30 AM, January 7, 1955. Cement was circulated to surface filling the entire annulus. The 13-3/8" conductor pipe was tested with 1000# for 30 minutes.
