DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

We filled hole with heavy mud to 5000', ran a Halliburton plug of 20 sacks of cement. Let set 1 1/4 hours, then tested by running drill pipe back on plug. Filled with heavy mud to 2150' and ran a Halliburton plug of 20 sacks of cement. Let set 2 1/4 hours, tested by running drill pipe back on plug. Knocked off 8 5/8" pipe at 1100' and recovered same. Filled hole with heavy mud to surface, and erected regulation marker using 10 sacks of cement.
