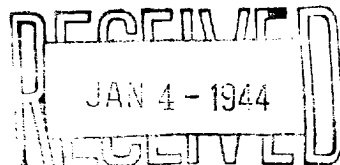

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

We dumped 15 sacks of cement in bottom of hole and filled with heavy mud to 2100'. Bridged and run plug of 10 sacks of cement. Then filled hole with heavy mud to 225', bridged and cemented with 10 sacks of cement. Filled hole with heavy mud to surface and erected a regulation marker. Work was done by Halliburton.
