DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On April 6, 1952 at 7:00 a.m., 48 hours had elapsed since running 4486' of new 9-5/8" casing landed at 4506 and cemented in two stages as follows:

First stage cemented with 400 sacks cement plus 8% Gel plus 100 sacks neat cement.

Second stage cemented through staging collar at 2213' with 100 sacks neat cement.

Casing shut-off was tested to 1000 psi for 30 minutes before and after drilling staging tool, as well as before and after drilling casing shoe. Since there was no drop in pressure, drilling operations were resumed.
