FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On April 6, 1952 at 7:00 A.M., 48 hours will have elapsed since running 4 1/2" of new 9-5/8" casing landed at 4506' and cemented in two stages as follows:

First stage cemented with 400 sacks cement plus 8% gel plus 100 sacks neat cement.

Second stage cemented through staging collar at 2213' with 100 sacks neat cement.

Casing shut-off will be tested to 1000 psi for 30 minutes before and after drilling staging tool as well as before and after drilling casing shoe. Providing there is no appreciable drop in pressure, drilling operations will be resumed.
