FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Well originally completed w/perforations extending from 12,004.5' to 12,034'.
Initial production amounted to 480 bbls. fluid through 3/4" choke with 100 psi tubing head pressure (367 bbls. oil and 113 bbls. water) - flowing by heads.
Acidified above perforations w/3000 gals 15% HCL Acid after which well produced 100% water by snubbing.

It is planned to plug back and perforate the 5-1/2" casing opposite the Devonian from 11,785' to 11,840'.
