DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Perforated 5 1/2" casing opposite the Devonian Formation from 11,815'-11,843' (11,843'-11,845' previously perforated to test for cement job). Overall perforations 11,815'-11,845'. Ran completion material. Tested to tank for 24 hours. Well produced 383 bbls. oil with 0.2% basic sediment, no water, through a 20/64" choke with 375 PSI tubing pressure. G. O. R. 94:1.
