Gentlemen:

Barbara Fasken respectfully requests a temporary test allowable of 365 bopd for the subject well. This well was recently converted to disposal and began to flow oil at rates in excess of 700 bpd before salt water injection commenced. A temporary allowable of 365 bopd is requested for 60 days to allow sufficient testing of the subject well. The production is believed to be coming from Devonian perforations at 11,770'-11,800'. Mississippian perforations at 11,142'-11,222' are also open below the packer.

Should the well continue to produce oil in commercial quantities after 60 days, then appropriate filings will be submitted to return this well to a active producing status. Otherwise, the well will be placed on salt water injection. Please call me at 915-687-1777 if you have any questions.
