FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At 1:00 a.m. on august 17, 1951, 32 hours will have elapsed since running 9-5/8" casing set at 4674 and cemented in two stages. First stage was cemented with 375 sacks of 8% gel cement and 100 sacks of meat cement. Circulated 6 hours through staging tool and cemented second stage with 150 sacks of neat cement. Temperature survey indicated top of cement at 1760'.

At the above time casing will be tested with 1000 psi before and after drilling each stage. If tests are satisfactory drilling will be resumed.
