DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 8:00 A.M. on July 30, 1951, 50 hours had elapsed since running 314' of 13-3/8" casing set at 334' and cemented with 500 sacks of cement. Casing was tested 30 minutes with 500 PSI before drlg plug with no drop in pressure. Plug was then drilled and casing was tested for 30 minutes with 500 PSI with no drop in pressure. Tests were considered satisfactory and drilling was resumed.
