## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 1:30 A.M. on March 9, 1952, 48 hours had elapsed since running 9797' of 7" new casing landed at 9818' and cemented with 150 sacks of cement mixed 43 gal plus 150 cu. ft. of perolite. Float collar was drilled and casing was tested for thirty minutes with 1000 psi. No drop in pressure occurred. Float shoe was not drilled. Tests were considered satisfactory and completion operations were resumed. Temperature survey indicated top of cement at 8510'.
