DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On January 7, 1952 at 11:40 P.M., 48 hours had elapsed since running 4481' of 9-5/8" new casing landed at 4500 and cementing in two stages with DV tool set at 2311. First stage was cemented with 350 sacks of 8% gel and 100 sacks neat. Second stage was cemented with 150 sacks of neat. Casing shut off was tested to 1000 psi for 30 minutes after drilling DV tool and cement shoe. No appreciable drop in pressure was noted for the 30 minute period and the test was considered satisfactory. Drilling operations have been resumed.
