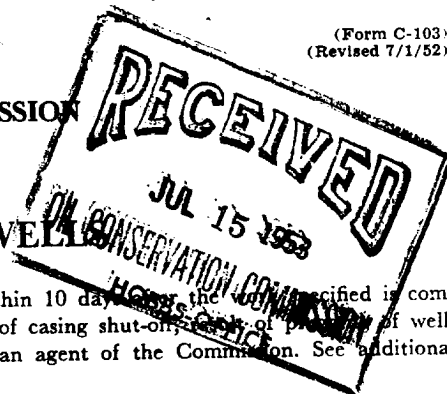

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On July 1, 1953 ran 12016' of 7" casing landed at 12034' and cemented with 630 sacks 45 gel cement plus 630 cu. ft. perlite. Temperature survey indicated top of cement behind casing at 8145'. Rigged down rotary tools and moved in reverse circulation rig to complete. On July 11, 1953 drilled out cement to 11984' and tested casing with 1100 psi for 30 minutes and as there was no drop in pressure completion operations were resumed.

\*Stanolind Company Rig #8 was dismantled and moved out and J. P. (Bum) Gibbins Reverse Circulation rig was moved in to complete well.
