DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On December 12, 1953 4481' of 9-5/8" casing was run and set at 4493' with 440 sacks 8% gel plus 100 sx. neat the first stage and 150 sx. neat the second stage with the staging tool set at approximately 2275' to isolate the salt section. After 30 hours W. O. C. tested casing above staging tool with 1075 psi for 30 minutes with no loss in pressure. Tested casing before and after drilling plug with 1150 psi and as there was no loss in pressure drilling operations were resumed.
