Gentlemen:

We request administrative approval by the Secretary-Director of the Commission for an exception to the requirements of Rule 112-A (1), for the dual completion of the above-captioned well.

All conditions for administrative approval have been met. They are as follows:

1. The well is to be dually completed within the limits of two defined pools or within one mile thereof, and the Commission has previously authorized the similar dual completion of a well in the same zones as proposed. (Nearburg & Ingram No. 1 Midhurst - Order No. R-1837).
2. The well is to be completed as an oil-oil dual completion and the hydrocarbons from each of the two zones can be safely and efficiently produced through parallel strings of tubing.
3. All strings of tubing used for the production of oil in the proposed dual completion will have a nominal inside diameter of not less than 1.670 inches nor greater than 2.50 inches.
4. The packer used to segregate the separate zones of the dual completion is a production-type packer and shall effectively prevent communication between all producing zones.
