Gentlemen:

We request administrative approval by the Secretary-Director of the Commission for an exception to the requirements of Rule 112-A (1), for the dual completion of the above-captioned well.

All conditions for administrative approval have been met. They are as follows:

- 1. The well is to be dually completed within the limits of two defined pools or within one mile thereof, and the Commission has previously authorized the similar dual completion of a well in the same zones as proposed. (Nearburg & Ingram No. 1 Midhurst Order No. R-1837).
- 2. The well is to be completed as an oil-oil dual completion and the hydrocarbons from each of the two zones can be safely and efficiently produced through parallel strings of tubing.
- 3. All strings of tubing used for the production of oil in the proposed dual completion will have a nominal inside diameter of not less than 1.670 inches nor greater than 2.50 inches.
- 4. The packer used to segregate the separate zones of the dual completion is a production-type packer and shall effectively prevent communication between all producing zones.
