Gentlemen:

Confirming my telephone conversation this date with Mr. Miller concern-  
ing Sunray Mid-Continent Oil Company's applications to dispose of salt  
water into its G.K. McDonald No. 1, this is to advise that the portion  
of our application denoted by asterisks (\*) is what we propose to do  
when our application is approved and that Sunray Mid-Continent will not  
deviate from this proposed operation without approval from the Commission.  
In other words, the 8 5/8" casing will be perforated from 1990' to 2110'  
and salt water will be injected down the 8 5/8" casing into these per-  
forations.

By copy of this letter, the State Engineer's Office is being advised  
that the correct location of the G.K. McDonald No. 1 is 660' FSL and  
660' FEL of Section 1, T13S, R37E, Lea County, New Mexico.
