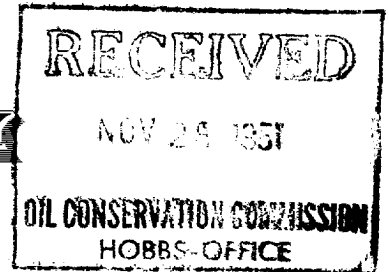

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

TD 12,603. 10 DST were run in the interval from 9589' - 12603' with no commercial show of oil or gas except on DST #1 from 9589' - 9638' where 220' oil and gas cut drilling mud - 5% oil was recovered.

Since the well was drilled through the Devonian Formation and it was unproductive it is planned to plug back and complete in the Wolfcamp. In view of the above a string of production casing was not run; therefore, the plugging back operation will be in 8-3/4" open hole.

~~THE FOLLOWING PROCEEDING IS RECOMMENDED FOR PLUGGING BACK:~~

1. Plug back to top of Woodford Shale at 12,480' with 70 sack of cement.
2. Mud from 12,480' to 10,163'.
3. Plug back from 10,163' to 10,090' with 42 sack of cement to plug off interval tested on DST #7.
4. Mud from 10,090' to 9855'.
5. Plug back from 9855' to 9650' with 117 sack of cement.
6. Drill out cement plug to 9700' and run 7" production string.

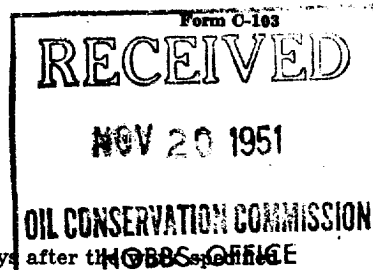

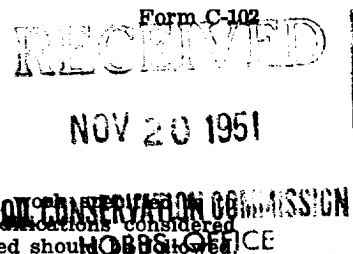
