FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

It is proposed to squeeze the re-perforated section from 10,142' to 10,152' with cement using Baker Oil Tool retrievable cement retainer at 10,075'.

After squeeze job and waiting on cement to set, it is proposed to drill out cement from casing and test for shut off of perforations.

The casing will be perforated at 10,195' with 2 shots, and then squeezed with cement at this water-oil contact point using a Baker Oil Tool retrievable cement retainer. This plug is to be drilled out and the perforations tested for shut off.

Then it is proposed to perforate the casing in the area from 10,142' to approximately 10,170' and drill stem test for penetration.

If penetration is made through the casing and production of oil is low, then it is proposed to treat perforated section with acid and test.
