DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Following the cementing of the 5 1/2" O. D. casing at 10,405' a temperature survey was made showing the cement top to be 5650' from the surface.

The casing was packed off in the casing head and tested after which the plug and float collar were drilled and cement drilled out to 10,400' into cement joint, and the casing was tested with 4 1500 pressure with no drop recorded for 30 minutes.

The casing was to have been perforated from 10,142' to 10,152' with 40 shots and the holes drill stem tested for penetration.
