**FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK**

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At a total depth of 13,145' salt water was encountered in a drill stem test of the Devonian formation topped at 13,085'. No showing of oil or gas was found.

It is proposed to plug back to a depth of 10,400' and attempt a completion in the Wolfcamp formation.

A cement plug is to be spotted from 13,085' up to 12,980' and another plug from 10,500' up to 10,342' by Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Company. The top plug is to be drilled out to 10,400' and 5 1/2" O.D. # 17 casing is to be run and cemented at that depth with 800 sks. of cement and gel equivalent to 1177 sks.

Mr. R. S. Blynn, Engineer, Oil Conservation Commission, Hobbs, N. M., was consulted prior to filing this notice.
