## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

At a depth of 4630' in line at 12:15 AM on May 25, 1951, 9 5/8" O.D. new casing was cemented at 4629' with 1300 sks. 14% Gel cement, 250 sks. Strata Grite, and 200 sks. neat cement.

Halliburton temperature survey showed the top of the cement to be 1300 feet from the surface. This was taken 12 hours following the pumping down of the cement plug.

The casing test on this pipe is to be taken between midnight and daylight on the morning of May 27, 1951. Drilling of the cement inside the casing will begin soon after midnight on that date which is more than 48 hours after completion of cement job.
