SW 1/4 NW 26 (40-acre Subdivision) 13-8, T. 37-E, NMPM, Wildcat Pool

Lea County.

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

This well was drilled to a total depth of 13,495' into Devonian lime on 10-27-53. Only a slight show of oil and gas from a drill stem test from 11,329 to 11,370' was found prior to the recovery of 10,070 feet of salt water on a drill stem test from 13,401 to 13,495' in Devonian lime.

On 10-29-53 verbal permission was given by Mr. A. L. Porter to plug and abandon this well as follows:

With the hole filled with heavy drilling mud, cement plugs would be placed from 13,309' to 13,370' (Top of Devonian by electric log) and from 11,284' to 11,370' and from 4,653' to 4,756'. An attempt would be made to recover a possible 2,300' of 9 5/8" casing after which a 35 feet plug would be spotted at the point of separation. A cement plug would then be spotted from 228' to 322' and then 10 sks. of cement placed in the top of the 13 3/8" casing and a steel cap welded on top of the casing with the required 4" steel marker installed above the sealed casing.

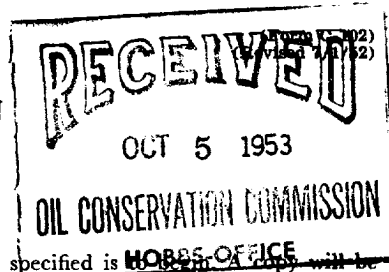

Form C-101 filed 1-11-53 indicated plans to drill to an approximate depth of 12,500'.

After drilling to a depth of 12,525' on 9-30-53, surveys were made on 10-1-53, after which it was decided to deepen to the Devonian formation.

It is proposed to deepen this well to 13,500' or to Devonian fluid at a lesser depth. On 10-2-53 verbal approval was given by Mr. A.L. Porter, Oil Conservation Commission Supervisor & proration manager.
