Reference is made to the Oil Conservation Commission forms on the above-captioned wells which, according to our records, have been drilled in New Mexico during the past 15 months. Our Hobbs office has informed me that they have been unable to secure any of the details concerning the drilling of these wells, and that you have ignored the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

The irregularities and discrepancies concerning these wells are too numerous to outline, and it is my opinion that further correspondence concerning the exact discrepancies is useless. I therefore suggest that you or one of your representatives visit our Hobbs office, located at 1000 West Broadway, and discuss the entire proceedings with our engineer, Mr. Stanley. In the event these discrepancies are not corrected by March 1, 1955, it is my intention to turn the matter over to the Attorney General of New Mexico, in conformance with our statute.

I would like to call your attention to the provisions of Section 24 of our statute, which provides for penalties of \$1,000.00 per day for each violation. It may appear to you that the discrepancies involving these wells are rather insignificant, but we do not consider any violation of our rules as insignificant, especially when your drilling operations

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are in a water-basin area, and also in an area where improper plugging would result in severe damage.

I hope that you will handle this matter immediately, so that future correspondence concerning your operations in New Mexico will not be necessary.
