FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK  
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Pull tubing and Kobe Equipment. Production was from perforations at 12,625'-12,665' with a Baker Production Packer at 12,600'. This zone will be plugged back with a Bridge Plug and cement plug on top of Bridge Plug. The Mississippian will be perforated from 11,726'-11,732', and 11,737'-11,742'. A Baker Production Packer will be set and this zone tested. If successful, this zone will be placed on production. If unsuccessful, this zone will be isolated with a Bridge Plug and cement plug also. The Canyon Lime Section from 10,791'-10,804' will be tested. If unsuccessful it will be isolated in the same manner as above and the Wolfcamp from 9,390'-9,408' will be tested. If all are unsuccessful, the well will be plugged and abandoned according to Commission Regulations.
