The following is report of State of New Mexico "W" Well No. 1, this being an old hole drilled and plugged by McAlister Fuel Company, originally drilled as State BJ #1 in center of NW/4 of SE/4 Sec. 2-14S-37E, Lea County, to 10,915', and plugged and abandoned on September 9, 1952. 13-3/8" casing was set @ 272' in 400 sacks cement and 9-5/8" casing was set @ 4697' in 1620 sacks cement.

DST 11124-256', tool open 3 hrs., recovered 2200' gas, 450' SGCM, and 1800' SW, FP 725-1705, 15 min. SIP 1910#.

Today's depth 12497' - lime, shale - drilling.
